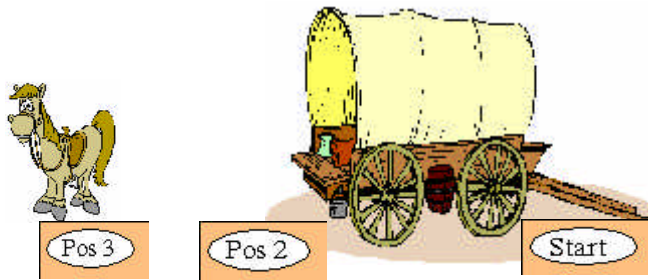
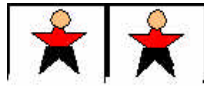


STAGE 2 BUFFALO HUNT

SCENARIO: You've had a long day of hunting buffalo with your trusty Sharps. After shooting your fifth buffalo, you bring the wagon up to load the hides in to take back to town. About the time you climb down off the wagon, you hear a scream and find your hunting party under attack by Indians.

SET-UP: Rifle targets at 15-25 yards. Shotgun and Pistol targets at 8-10 yards.

AMMO

- **SHOTGUN** **6**
- **PISTOL** **10**
- **RIFLE** **5**

WEAPONS STAGED

- Shotgun in scabbard on horse
- Pistols Holstered.
- Rifle empty action open in hand at port arms

STARTING POSITION: **Standing** beside the wagon with empty rifle at port arms

AT THE BUZZER: **Shoot** the rifle target five times. You must load singly from your body. Place the rifle, action open in the wagon and move to the back of the wagon. Draw your pistols and shoot the five pistol targets with each pistol in any order (you must shoot at each target with each pistol). Holster your empty pistols and move to the horse. Retrieve the shotgun and sweep the shotgun targets three times. This is a gunfighter friendly stage. Gunfighters may change leads as long as no more than two consecutive shots are fired with either pistol and the targets are engaged in accordance with stage instructions.

PROCEDURALS & SCORING

+10 Second Penalty for failure to comply with scenario instructions as written. Each target not engaged with the specific firearm required by stage instructions will be scored as a miss.
